



Winter is Coming!!!!!!!!!!!!

and with that comes cold and snow. As we start off a new winter season, the Police Department would like to remind you about the Snow Emergency Ordinance. Ordinance 70-14 authorizes the Street Superintendent to declare a Snow Emergency whenever 3 inches of snow has fallen or is predicted to fall. Once a Snow Emergency has been declared, the following applies between midnight and 8 a.m.:

- Even-odd side parking is in effect. Parking is permitted on the even side of the street on even numbered days, and on the odd side on odd numbered days. The house numbers for that street dictate if the side is even or odd. Remember though, that the date that is in effect is the date after midnight.
- Other parking restrictions remain in effect. In other words, if it is an even side night, but the even side has a prohibition against parking there, you can not park there.
- Snow Emergencies are in effect for 3 consecutive nights.
- Vehicles which remain unmoved 24 hours after being issued a parking citation are subject to being towed.
- Listen to local media outlets for the declaration announcement of a snow emergency or check the Street Department website at www.ci.stoughton.wi.us/streets/.

Thank you for your cooperation. It is our hope that by being able to clear streets of snow, we will have a safer and more easily traveled city.

SAND BARREL LOCATIONS: (1) Stoughton Street Department at 515 S. Fourth Street. (2) Lincoln & Roby Intersection {on the south side of Lincoln between the corner and Hillcrest} (3) Depot Hill and (4) Pedestrian Hill {off Forton Street}. **Remember to bring your own bucket and shovel.**



CHRISTMAS TREE PICK UP: Wednesday, January 2nd through Thursday, January 31st. Crews will pick up trees at the curb.

- 1) Please make sure that your tree is not buried in the snow.
- 2) Trees, roping and wreaths must have all wire removed.

PARK ROW TREE PRUNING: Begins in January and goes thru March, **weather permitting**. If you have a park row tree you feel needs trimming, please contact the Street Department @ 873-6303. More specific information will be in the local newspapers.
