## Home Project Idea

If you are thinking of putting in a concrete patio or driveway, consider pavers. This is a more green solution to dealing with the Oregon mud. When we solidly cover the earth with concrete we are taking that amount of land out of production of any green material as well as making it virtually unable to absorb the Oregon rains.

Pavers are 'soft set' on a sand and gravel bed, with sand simply swept between the joints. This is a project that can be done by a marginally handy person with a reasonably strong back. It can also be hired out and there are plenty of contractors that do this work. The pavers can look like rectangular or square cobblestones, or have a more formal geometric appearance...they also come in a variety of earthy colors to match your landscaping or home.

The surface is beautiful, solid but absorbent, and mostly maintenance-free. It just needs a little vinegar sprayed on any stray blades of grass that try to peek through the edges, and a yearly bucket of sand, to sweep into any open cracks.
