19.08.080 Emergency waiver.

Where a tree is determined by the city planner or designee to be in a dangerous condition requiring emergency action to preserve the public health, safety and welfare, the permit requirement may be waived. In the event of an emergency caused by a hazardous or dangerous tree, which condition poses an immediate threat to person or property, any member of the Foothill fire protection district may authorize the destruction or removal of such tree without securing a permit therefor.
